Food Vendor Spaces (F1 through F8) General Vendor Spaces (1 through 49) PLEASE KEEP THE MAP PORTION FOR YOUR RECORDS. Spaces will be assigned on a first come, first served basis, upon receipt of application and payment. No spaces are reserved from year to year. Applications are due by July 15th, 2019.

Spaces must be set-up between & 7:00 am & 9:00 AM (please no earlier than 7:00) on day of event. We reserve the right to fill any empty spaces after 9:00 AM. In the event you arrive after 9:00 AM, and your space has been reassigned, we will make a reasonable attempt to provide another space for you. Your fee will not be refunded.

All food vendors must provide the OBA with a copy of their ServSafe Certification in order to participate in the event. Call the Wareham Board of Health Office at 508-291-3100 x3197. There is a \$100.00 fee to participate required by the BOH, payable to them. A \$150.00 fee can be paid for an unlimited permit to be a food vendor in Wareham at multiple events. This is mandatory and must be completed 2 weeks prior to this event.

Vendors are responsible for clean-up of their booth space after event. Public bathrooms are available on-site and across the street on the town pier. **FOOD Vendors** will have access to power and cold water.

Spaces will be assigned on a first come, first served basis, upon receipt of application and payment. No spaces are reserved from year to year. Applications are due by July 15th, 2018.

Tents or canopies must be secured with stakes or other means.

The Town street parking regulations will be in force. Free parking for vendors will be provided off site at the Boys and Girls Club on Highland Ave. **inside the chain link fence**. It is a 2 minute walk back to the flea market grounds.

Materials that (in the OBA's opinion) are offensive (i.e., inappropriate language on clothing, etc.) shall not be displayed. Failure to comply with this rule may result in vendor being asked to leave the Event.
